

2017 Pre-Season High School

Tournament Rules

1. The Tournament will be a five game guarantee. You will be in a pool of six teams and you will play everyone in your pool.
2. **No food/drink of any type is allowed in the Softball Complexes. The Sacramento Complex has a full service restaurant and their contract states NO OUTSIDE FOOD brought into the complex.** 1 team ice chests will be allowed and must be kept in the team's dugout.
3. Two Coaches and a scorekeeper will be allowed free entry, all others must pay. Adults \$5 seniors 55/Up \$ 3
Students 17/under \$ 3 Children 10/U **Free**
4. Game times will be as scheduled except in the case bad weather. All teams must be ready to play at game time. Tournament Director has the right to change game times and locations if needed. It's the coach's responsibility to check game times and field location
5. The tournament will be played under the C.I.F. rules except as indicated in the local ground rules. Games will be **1-hr30 minutes.** No new inning will begin after the allotted time. If the score is tied after 7 innings or 1 hour 30 minutes the game will end in a tie. Run rule: 8 runs after 5 innings of play.
6. Teams are limited to 18 Players. Changes, Substitutions or Additions to Rosters will be permitted up to 15 minutes prior to team's first scheduled game. The Tournament Director must approve any changes in the roster. All teams must submit a team roster before your first game. **CIF requires all coaches on the field shall wear a protective coaches helmet**
7. Game times are subject to change if inclement weather demands. Phone numbers for Tournament Information:

8. The flip of a coin will determine home team. The team on top of bracket will occupy 3rd base dugout during the elimination rounds.
9. There will be no infield practice between games. The pitcher will get five warm-up pitches between innings, and the ball will be returned back to the pitcher after every out. Each team will get one warning, and then a ball will be called thereafter.
10. In all protests the coach will be the only one to discuss the situation with the umpires and Tournament Official if necessary. All protest must be settled before the next pitch.
11. **Each coach is responsible for making sure the scores are reported to Tournament Director at your field and are correct. Please check the bracket boards for your next game time before leaving complex. DON'T ASSUME**
12. No Skate Boards, Skates, Bikes, Razor Scooters, remote Cars will be allowed in the Softball Complexes. Individuals will be asked to remove the item and if they refuse the Park Security will be called to remove them.
